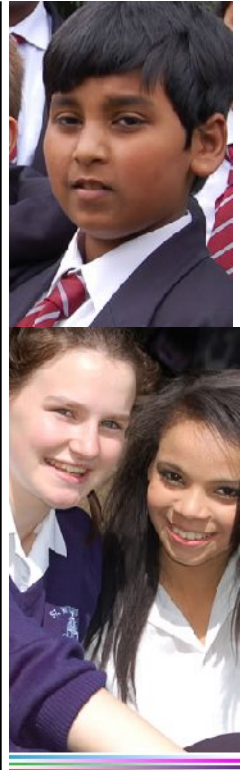

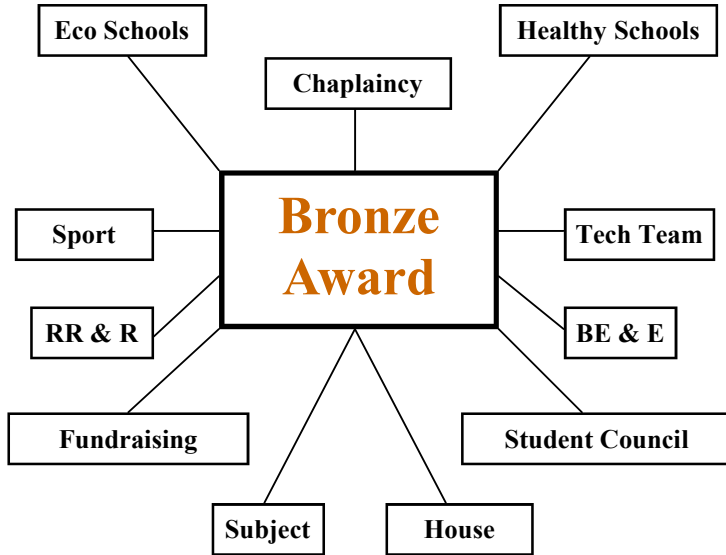
Dear Student Leader
