

Catch Up Programme of Support

16 to 19 funding: 16 to 19 tuition fund

Additional funding for the academic years 2020 to 2021 and 2021 to 2022 for schools, colleges and other 16 to 19 institutions to mitigate the disruption to learning to rise from coronavirus (COVID-19).

The funding is to support small group tuition for students aged 16 to 19 in English, Maths and other subjects that have been disrupted, including vocational and/or academic learning.

Proposed tutorial:

Group tutor sessions will be offered to students who match the criteria. Group sizes will not exceed 7 and where possible the groups will be lower in size. Initially this will be for students who have not achieved a 4 in maths or English and will be offered an opportunity to re-take these qualifications.

If sufficient provision is arranged and there is additional tutor time available, vocational qualifications will be reviewed and allocated time for catch up mentoring and support.

Once this provision has been arranged and if there is additional tutor time, then the Deputy & Director of VI form will consult with subject leaders to review any further distribution of support.

The criteria for this will be based on prior attainment, as well as guidelines outlined in the supporting students section of the 16 to 19 funding: 16 to 19 tuition fund 2021-22.

Provision

Based on an average costing of £25 per hour, which will include preparation time and 1 support email per week. St Wilfrid's will seek to provide 240hrs of tutoring. The initial allocation will be for 2hrs per week until the GCSE November window $1^{st} - 11^{th}$ November 2021.

Upon completion of the window the provision will be re-allocated as previously stated at 1 hour per week, based on subject need.

Quality assurance

Sessions will be delivered by ECT with the direct support of the Director of VI Form and subject leaders, in consultation with the Assistant Head Teacher in charge of professional development. All session progression will be recorded as part of professional development for ECT.
