How to access your school email; work from class via TEAMS and online versions of Word, Excel and Powerpoint.


It has come to our attention that if you are using a MacBook to use TEAMS via safari rather than the APP – newer MACOS security settings may cause there to be issues in opening TEAMS online. If this is a problem you are experiencing; the following will solve the problem for you:

Open Safari – click on top left corner "safari" menu. Choose Preferences>Privacy and uncheck "Prevent cross-site tracking"

Close Safari

Reopen Safari – then go to Office.com and log in.






You'll get a screen something like this (Staff have a slightly different view!)






The online version of Word has a function called "immersive reader" that can read a text out loud to you, tell you what individual words mean and even translate it into another language. It also has a dictation function, so you can speak to it and it will type what you are saying!

If you are not sure or have problems, either email your form tutor, subject teacher or Mrs Denyer for help.






Your Home learning work will be set via assignments on TEAMS

You can also search for your assignments by clicking on the assignments icon.




To view the assignment details click on the **View** assignment button.
