

EXAM CLASHES INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS

A “clash” means that you have multiple exams timetabled on the same day at the same time.

Obviously you cannot do two exams at the same time so to resolve clash one of the exams will have been moved to earlier or later on the same day.

Where an exam has been re-scheduled to run later within the same session you will not be able to leave the room between exams. You will be given a short supervised break in the exam room and if needed you may be escorted to the toilet by a member of staff.

If an exam has been re-scheduled to another session on the same day, you will have to be supervised from the end of one exam until the start of the next one. This supervision may take place outside the exam room (e.g. in a classroom) and you will be allowed to revise using your own books and notes, however, you must not:

- Be in possession of a mobile phone or any other electronic communication or storage device
- Have access to the internet
- Have contact with any students outside of the supervision room
- Be coached by a member of centre staff.

You will be asked to bring in a packed lunch as you will not be able to buy food or eat your lunch in The Wedge.
